Guarantee that every student will either achieve NMS in literacy or numeracy for their year level or have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.


- Increase % of Year 3 students at NMS in reading from 64.5% to 80% by end 2016 and 90% by 2017
- Increase % of Year 3 students in U2 Bands in reading from 4.8% to 10% in 2016 and 15% in 2017
- Increase % of Year 7 students at NMS in reading from 78.6% to 90% in 2016 and 100% in 2017
- Increase % of Year 9 students at NMS in reading from 42.9% to 60% in 2016 & 70% in 2017

### Our initiatives include

- Provide 0.8 Capability Officer (DP level) to work across College
- Further implement RoleM (Representations, Oral Language and Engagement in Mathematics) in Pre-Prep to Year 3 using a coaching and feedback model, by expert teachers and external providers through a research project conducted by ACU
- Establish Responsible Behaviour Officer positions (top up of Ministers \$)
- Provide a full-time teacher aide for all classes
- Reading (Big 6) – Kia Morton
- Utilise Pre-Prep expertise (Ben Walker – FaFT; Di Hoy)
- Utilise ESCM expertise (Di Hoy)
- Utilise QCAA expertise in moderation and assessment for Bamaga Senior Campus.
- Engage Anita Archer (if available) for in-service
